### Notes:

- a There are 2 Semesters each year, with one module running in each Semester. The first taught module of study must be started in the September semester. Whilst the normal path is undertaking the 4 taught modules at 2 per year for two years, deferment of a module after the first module of the course is possible by agreement with the Course Leader.
- b The fees for each module are due in full by the end of the first Study Block of that module). Once a module has started the full module fee is due, even if the student withdraws part-way through.
- c The module fee includes lunch and tea (as applicable) during Study Blocks. Overnight accommodation is not included.
- d Successful completion of years 1 and 2 is required before progressing on to the Dissertation. Once the Course Leader has registered a student for the Dissertation, the full fees for the Dissertation are due.
- e Overnight accommodation is not included in the module fees. If required, this should be booked in advance and paid for at the start of the Study Block. Accommodation and meals at other times outside the Study Blocks may be possible – these should be booked in advance with Reception and paid for at the start of the stay. Meals outside Study Blocks will be charged at normal College Guest rates.
- f The Registration Fee is payable prior to the start of the course – students cannot be regarded as Registered Students until this has been received and other standard Admissions criteria fulfilled.

### General Notes:

- 1 Fees shown are applicable only for the 2010/2011 academic year and are likely to rise for the following year.
