### Notes:

- a Fees are payable in 3 termly instalments (totalling the amount shown per annum) during the first week of each term unless otherwise specified. The total fees due are Tuition plus Maintenance plus Other Costs (as applicable). Maintenance Costs for the part-time CertHE and Moorlands Certificate courses are 50% of the Non-resident charges.
- b Course contents for the Moorlands Certificate need to be agreed in advance with the Director of Studies.
- c Tuition Costs for the Accelerate course include Maintenance Charges, but not Student Amenities or Registration charges.
- d Spouse's Morning covers attendance at one morning of lectures per week, including lunch.
- e Residential Maintenance fees cover the term-time provision of a furnished room, use of College facilities, use of the College washing machines, light and heat. Meals are provided on a full-board basis during term-time only. Students occupying a single room may be required to share with a Foundation student for one night per week – no reduction will be given for this. Students may stay free by prior arrangement during half-terms in return for a minimal workduty, but meals are not provided.
- f House charges cover the use of College facilities. Lunch is provided for College-based students on weekdays during term-time. Placement-based students have lunch provided one day per week during term-time, with lunch and tea provided during block study weeks – accommodation (B & B) during block study weeks may be available at an extra charge (£17 per night).
- g The maintenance charge for Foundation students covers term time provision of lunch two days per week (£95 per term) and if required accommodation (usually shared room) one night per week (£240 per term inclusive of meals).
- h The Registration Fee is payable prior to the start of the course – students cannot be regarded as Registered Students until this has been received and other standard Admissions criteria fulfilled.

### General Notes:

- 1 Fees are due by the end of the first week of each term – full conditions are set out in the Student Handbook. A discount is given if the full fees for the year are paid before or during the first week of the Autumn Term.
- 2 Where, in exceptional circumstances, a student withdraws from the course during the year, the full fees for the year are due (see Student Handbook for details).
- 3 Fees shown are applicable only for the 2010/11 academic year and are likely to rise for the following year.
- 4 Other costs (e.g. visitors' meals/accommodation, photocopying, printing, etc.) are given in the Student Handbook.
