MA in Language Community & Development Fees: Academic Year 2019/2020

Payment of Fees:

- 1 The fee for each stage of the MA, or group of modules, is due in full before that stage, or group, starts. Once started, the full fee applies, even if the student withdraws partway through. The annual enrolment fee is also due at the start of each stage, or group, and must be paid by any student taking validated modules.
- 2 Students may only proceed to the next stage of study if fees for the previous stage have been fully paid.
- 3 Fees shown are applicable only for the relevant academic year (from September to August) and are likely to rise, normally in line with inflation, in future years.

Notes:

- a The enrolment fee is payable for every academic year (Sep to Aug) the student is enrolled in a stage of the MA, or for each stage, whether or not modules are taken.
- b Students require 180 CATS points for the MA and normally take modules totalling 60 CATS points per stage (ie Certificate, Diploma and Dissertation).
- c The registration charge is payable prior to the start of the course. This is a one-off charge for the registration of new students and is not refundable.
- d The discounted registration charge will apply for all new students registering within two weeks of the offer of a place.
- e On-site residential maintenance fees (PGCert) cover the provision of a furnished room (single occupancy, shared bathroom) for 22 weeks, meals on a full-board basis, wifi, light, heat and use of shared lounge, kitchen and laundry facilities. This does not cover accommodation or meals for the two weeks of the Christmas break.
- f Non-residential maintenance fee for PGCert or PGDip covers 2-course lunches and teas and coffees on teaching days (20 weeks Mon-Fri) and any orientation days. Per week equivalents are shown for modules or part courses.
- g Non-residential maintenance fee for PGCert or PGDip covers teas and coffees on teaching days (20 weeks Mon-Fri) and any orientation days. Per week equivalents are shown for modules or part courses.
- h On-site residential maintenance fees (PGDip) cover the provision of a furnished room (single occupancy, shared bathroom) for 21 weeks, meals on a full-board basis for 20 weeks, wifi, light, heat and use of shared lounge, kitchen and laundry facilities. Meals are not provided over the week of the Easter break.
