

# SCHOLAR

## Financial Support Package

The SCHOLAR financial support package is designed to encourage applications from those who have previously excelled in studies. It is applicable for all undergraduate students of the College. SCHOLAR grants may be made towards tuition, accommodation or any other fees.

This edition of the SCHOLAR package is operational for students starting in 2021 and thereafter. It is not related to the College's Access and Participation Plan.

A minimum of three applicants will be awarded grants each year, each grant being of £1500 towards the cost of each full-time year of their studies. The recipients will be the applicants with the highest previous qualifications. If a number of applicants have the same previous highest qualifications, equivalent in level and quality, all will receive a grant.

SCHOLAR is advertised on the College's externally facing website.

Decisions on awards are made by the College's Financial Support Panel on the basis of applications to study made by 1 July each year.

Responses are made by making a credit to the student's College fee account by the start of their studies. The money given is a grant, not a loan, and is not refundable (should the student not complete their studies). Receipt of support from the SCHOLAR package will have no impact on eligibility to apply for financial support under other packages.

There are no reporting requirements on recipients of support from SCHOLAR.
