Payment of Fees:

- 1 Where a student withdraws or suspends study from a course during the year, Tuition and Maintenance Fees will be charged according to the College's enrolment and registration policy.
- 2 Tuition Fees can be paid in full at the start of the academic year and a discount of 0.5% will be given if fees are paid by 20 October (the discount does not apply to Student Loan payments or one-off charges). Alternatively, payment of Tuition Fees can be spread over 3 equal instalments, to be paid by 20 October, 20 January and 30 April, unless otherwise agreed.
- 3 Any part-payment of instalments will be used first to clear Maintenance Fees and then Tuition Fees. Unpaid fees will be dealt with according to the student fee debt collection process. Failure to keep up with the schedule of payments may lead to a late payment penalty after 30 days or a suspension of enrolment from studies after 90 days.
- 4 Fees shown are applicable only for the current academic year and are likely to rise, normally in line with inflation, in future years.

Notes:

- a This fee covers the use of College accommodation and meals during the two BA study blocks held at Moorlands Christchurch campus.
- b Registration is a one-off charge that applies to all new students. It must be paid prior to the start of the course and is not refundable. The discounted registration charge will apply for all students registering before 31 May, or those registering within two weeks of the offer of a place.

Additional charges relating to Moorlands NI @ Youth Link:

There are five study block weeks held at this Regional Centre in Year 1, reducing to four study blocks in Years 2 and 3. Teas and coffees during these study blocks are provided but you will need to arrange and pay for your own meals and accommodation during those weeks, as needed.
