Payment of Fees and Charges:

- Where a student withdraws or suspends study from a course during the year, Tuition Fees and Maintenance Charges will be charged according to the College's enrolment and registration policy.
- Tuition Fees and Maintenance Charges can be paid in full at the start of the academic year and a discount of 0.5% will be given if these are paid by 20 October (the discount does not apply to Student Loan payments or one-off charges). Alternatively, payment of Tuition Fees and Maintenance Charges can be spread over 3 equal instalments, to be paid by 20 October, 20 January and 30 April, unless otherwise agreed.
- Any part-payment of instalments will be used first to clear Maintenance Charges and then Tuition Fees. Unpaid fees will be dealt with according to the student fee debt collection process. Failure to keep up with the schedule of payments may lead to a suspension of enrolment from studies after 90 days.
- 4 Fees and charges shown are applicable only for the current academic year and are likely to rise, normally in line with inflation, in future years.

Notes:

- a This charge covers the use of College accommodation and meals during the two BA study blocks held at Moorlands Campus in Christchurch.
- b If change of mode is agreed before 31 May in the prior academic year, this will be discounted by 50%.
