Payment of Fees and Charges:

- 1 Tuition Fees and Maintenance Charges for each stage of the MA, or group of modules, are due in full before that stage, or group, starts. The annual enrolment fee is also due at the start of each stage, or group, and must be paid by any student taking validated modules. Where a student withdraws or suspends study during the year, fees and charges will be charged according to the College's enrolment and registration policy.
- 2 Students may only proceed to the next stage of study if fees for the previous stage have been fully paid.
- 3 Fees and charges shown are applicable only for the relevant academic year (from August to July) and are likely to rise, normally in line with inflation, in future years.

Notes:

- a Students require 180 credits for the MA and normally take modules totalling 60 credits per stage (ie Certificate, Diploma and Dissertation).
- b The enrolment fee is payable for each stage in which the student is enrolled. Students who take consecutive stages may need to pay two enrolment fees in one academic year.
- c On-site residential maintenance charge (PGCert) covers the provision of a furnished room (single occupancy, normally shared bathroom) for 21.5 weeks, meals on a full-board basis, wifi, light, heat and use of shared lounge, kitchen and laundry facilities. This does not cover accommodation or meals for the two weeks of the Christmas break.
- d On-site residential maintenance charge (PGDip) covers the provision of a furnished room (single occupancy, normally shared bathroom) for 22 weeks, meals on a full-board basis for 21 weeks, wifi, light, heat and use of shared lounge, kitchen and laundry facilities. Meals are not provided over the week of the Easter break.
- e Non-residential maintenance charge for PGCert or PGDip covers lunches and sports and lounge facilities (including teas and coffees) on teaching days and any orientation days (20 weeks Mon-Fri). Per week equivalents are shown for modules or part courses.
- f Non-residential maintenance charge for PGCert or PGDip covers sports and lounge facilities (including teas and coffees) on teaching days and any orientation days (20 weeks Mon-Fri). Per week equivalents are shown for modules or part courses.
- g The registration charge is payable by new students prior to the start of the course. This is a one-off charge for the registration of new students and is not refundable. The discounted registration charge will apply for all new students registering within two weeks of the offer of a place.
- h This is the maximum charge; an application for RPL which is not complex may be discounted by 50%.
